On 23 June Belgium's Council of Ministers approved a decision requiring that all document exchanges within the services of the Belgian federal government be in an open, standard format. Only ODF is accepted as such a standard in the decision. The execution of this decision will be discussed in the coming months. We will keep you posted.

### **India: ODF Alliance-India Launched; Roadmap Laid to ODF Adoption**

India's first national seminar on ODF was held on 23 June in New Delhi, where ODF Alliance-India was officially launched and India's leading technical institutions, global IT companies and government agencies deliberated on how ODF could significantly change the way data is managed and help increase IT penetration. Mr. Shri R. Chandershekar, Joint Secretary of the Dept. of Information Technology at India's Ministry of Information & Technology, welcomed the formation of ODF Alliance-India, noting that ODF is a great technological leap and a big boon to further propel IT right to India's grass root levels.

### **EU: New COSPA Deliverables Expected; Alliance Joins As Observer**

The Consortium for Open Source in the Public Administrations (COSPA) is performing a controlled study on the adoption of open source and open data standards in the European public administrations, and published in March 2006 many useful resources, including migration toolkits. Several new deliverables are currently under review and expected to be available soon now that research has been completed. The COSPA project, coordinated by the University of Bolzano and including academic and public administration partners from Hungary, Denmark, Ireland, UK, and Belgium, as well as industrial partners, is funded by the EU's Sixth Framework Programme. The Alliance has joined COSPA as an observer.
